All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have other amendments. I have a priority motion. Senator Matzke would move for cloture on LB 712.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The motion before the body is, shall cloture be invoked. This is a motion there is no debate on. If it is successful then we vote on the matter pending. As I understand, Mr. Clerk, at this point there are no pending matters?

CLERK: Nothing has been presented to the Legislature at this point, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: So the vote then will be immediately on whether the bill should be advanced, is that correct?

CLERK: I believe so.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay. So the first vote before the body is, shall cloture be invoked? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke cloture.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Question before the body then is, shall LB 712 be advanced to E & R Engrossing? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 712.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 712 is advanced. LB 712A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 712A, Senator Maurstad, I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I would move to advance LB 712A to E & R for engrossment.
