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Usual and customary has been the frequent term used in reimbursement under insurance and other matters and so it does have more clarity to those who work in the area of hospital charges and other medical charges, so I think it does help and I would support the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Senator Matzke, your light is next.

SENATOR MATZKE: Madam President, I have nothing further to add unless there are some questions. I would consider this my closing.

SENATOR CROSBY: We have more speakers. I'm sorry.

SENATOR MATZKE: I see.

SENATOR CROSEY: Can't close yet. Senator Jensen. Senator Jensen, on the Matzke amendment.

SENATOR JENSEN: Madam President, members of the body, this is my priority bill and I think Senator Matzke has offered some language which clarifies the bill and certainly is acceptable and would also encourage the body to adopt the Matzke amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Hall on the Matzke amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President and members. I rise in opposition to the amendment because I'm not sure that it does what it purports to do and I, if I could, I'd like to ask Senator Matzke a question or two.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Matzke, will you respond?

SENATOR MATZKE: Yes.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Matzke, the purpose, as I understand your opening that you wanted to allow as your closing as well, is to have basically all hospitals, physicians or nurses charge roughly the same fee?

SENATOR MATZKE: No, that's not...
