On the fiscal question I might say that this certainly is not going to add to state expense in any regard because the system is now being changed to be a cash fund system and the fees are designed to pay for whatever costs there are in inspections. I just don't want the pendulum to swing too far back and I think we should not forget that a large part of our problems had to do with the greed of people and people in self-serving situations and there still needs to be some protection in the law applicable to those situations. I think this strikes a balance which I hope is acceptable to people. Thank you.
