It appears that there would be some reduction in litter fees but it is not at all clear whether it would be significant or insignificant. Ray was kind enough to say, well, since we don't know, we'll take his original amendment back off and deal with it straightforward as a bill next year and I look forward to that because the litter fee does, portion of the statutes does need some cleaning up and I think Ray is on the right track. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Janssen, there are no other lights on, would you like to close? Closing is waived. The question is, shall LB 581 be returned to Select File for purposes of a specific amendment? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is returned. Senator Janssen, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, I believe we have stated everything there is to state, so we'll just let her go.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you. Any discussion? I see no lights on. Any closing, I assume not. We will go, proceed to vote. All those in favor of adoption of the amendment indicate by voting aye, those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays. Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to advance 581 to E & R Final.
