SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: It's always...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...been this way.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Now...now the bene...the benefits are likewise.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I take that back. I mean two years ago there was a little different negotiated. Remember, if you were under 45,000 or if you're over 45...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...you got a flat versus a percentage, but this year, this is treated...everyone is...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...treated the same.

SENATOR ROBINSON: And that's...okay, let's say you're making 80,000 dollars so this year you're going to get a 4 percent raise, you're going to add 3,200 bucks to it, so next year you come back and your salary is 8,320 (sic) dollars. Say that we had the same again, which you're going to get 4 percent of that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Three and a half.

SENATOR ROBINSON: You're going to get 40 percent of 83,020.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Three and a half.

SENATOR ROBINSON: No, no, it'd be 3.5 next year, okay. Okay. That's what I wanted to know. Thank you.
