CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendments are adopted. We are now on the bill, LB 392. Discussion on LB 392? Senator Bernard-Stevens. Wait, Senator Wehrbein, did you want to open on the bill? Senator Wehrbein, would you like to open on 392?

CLERK: Senator Bernard-Stevens would move to indefinitely postpone the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Madam President, and members of the body, this is a procedural motion only. I wanted to have a block of...actually, I wanted to give Roger the chance to say on his first budget on the floor he first had to beat back a kill motion. So then he can tell his grandkids that...how tough it was. This is a procedural motion. I wanted to have a block of time where Senator Wehrbein and I could dis...engage in kind of a dialogue here on some of the departments, so in the ten minutes of opening that I would have on this I can do that without using up my three times that I may want to use, depends on what happens on discussion on the budget itself.
