

development, the Nebraska Benefits marketing campaign. It is an initiative by the Governor through the Department of Economic Development to try to sell Nebraska and market Nebraska as a place to do business. It puts in another 100,000 each year, or \$200,000 for international trade initiatives through the Department of Economic Development to encourage more marketing of and broader marketing of Nebraska products abroad. And it puts in 2 million each year, or \$4 million into LB 309 for deferred maintenance projects throughout the State of Nebraska of state owned buildings and property. So I will send out a...I will get this printed and have it sent out, if there is questions on that. It's the trailer bill. Frankly, it is a bill by the committee that we think are subjects that are worthy of consideration, but, obviously, aren't absolutely necessary, if you were to consider...if you wanted to consider them, but it is something that could be done. It is a little...it is a little difficult to say that it is absolutely necessary because they aren't. But it is something that if you were so inclined, this is an option that you might want to consider and I would leave it to you to make that decision. Someone else on the committee may want to speak to it, I don't know, but this is the so-called trailer bill for your consideration.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Wehrbein, and I have tried to write down, I still don't have the handout that...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I have got it. I apologize, I don't have it, I will have it done right now.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay. I was trying to catch the 309, is it 2 million the first year, a million the second year, or is it 2 and 2?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's...there is 2 million each year.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay, so a total of 4. And did I catch, did I catch that it was...there is \$100,000 in the budget for international trade, and then I heard another \$200,000 figure each year.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: One is 100,000 in the Department of Ag for trade initiatives.
