

200,000 would have been in the Department of Agriculture...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I try not to let my biases show sometimes.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: But if we help you on those biases, would you...would you like that better?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: (Laughter.) Well, I think there is plenty of room, but on the other hand, I think to be...to be fair about it, these are probably put in fairly. This is the initiative, I accept it for what it is.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator, and I'm actually waiting for that handout, so I am taking some time.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It should be there immediately, it's coming right now.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I will have her bring you one.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: That's okay, it's coming. On the 309 Task Force, the \$2 million, I guess what I am thinking of is if I remember correctly in reading late last night, and then what I have read in the paper that we...the committee in the bill that we advanced, LB 392, put in \$20 million into the Cash Reserve Fund.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: All right, now that puts that fund at what level? And that may be an unfair question to ask off the top when that file is already gone, but maybe Mike might...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thirty-eight million...or thirty...I don't...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: And...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We will have to look it up.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: ...the question I am asking, I guess, is if, in fact, if the 20 million was to get us up to the average that we need to be, then so be it. If the 20 million brings us over what we normally have needed in that fund, I
