

if you're inclined to do that, but the options are there and that's simply all I'm suggesting to you that the options are there. I would submit that they should stay there at least for another round of voting so that we can better all understand the implications of the budget and see what other bills are going to advance that require A bills. There's some commissions being advanced. We have not debated the crime bill yet. We have 425, the economic development issue, all of those are going to be out there facing probably the same dollars and so this is starting to focus. And I make no apologies that we have quite a broad range of areas to focus in on. We are several days away from making a final decision on the budget and the final form that that will be in and this simply sets the stage for those various projects to start to come together and focus as the body makes their decision, 49 of us. Thank you.
