SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We are voting on the...to cease debate, and Senator Avery...Senator Maurstad said he would accept call-in votes.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Elmer voting yes. Senator Vrtiska voting yes. Senator Landis voting yes. Senator Janssen voting yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Avery, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Bromm, Senator Brashear.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Robinson voting yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Coordsen, would you like to check in.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Schellpeper voting yes. Senator Warner voting yes. Senator Schimek voting yes. Senator Kristensen voting yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SENATOR CROSBY: Debate does cease. Senator Hudkins, would you like to close on your amendment?
