CLERK: Senator Preister, I now have AM1949. (Amendment appears on page 1964 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President, friends all. This amendment basically is an amendment that again deals with the issue that Senator Bromm raised and that's on what is in the best interest of the people in the area. The amendment is to deal with what is public interest. In dealing with that it says particularly in the interest of property owners within a ten mile radius of the area. And I believe that's printed in the Journal, and I believe it's on page 1964, AM1949. So if anyone did want to see that, I'll make you aware of that. Basically, I think that if there is going to be a controlled shooting area in a neighborhood, and I understand that this part of Douglas County has some development that's going in, there are people in the area that are certainly going to be directly impacted by the additional traffic and by what's going to be happening with controlled shooting area, that before a license is issue that those people, again, are considered in that process and are given some priority, and that priority should be higher than the interest of the entire state. So it is a simple amendment in its wording and it may have more implications. But basically it deals with the interest of property owners within a ten mile radius of the proposed area. It's listed on page 1964 in the Journal, and it's AM1949. With that, I would be happy to answer any questions that anyone may have.
