SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there anything that prohibits an enclosure around the entire controlled shooting area?

SENATOR AVERY: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there anything that says the area above the shooting area cannot be obstructed to prevent the birds from flying away? Is there anything that prevents that?

SENATOR AVERY: I don't believe so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there anything that says this controlled shooting area must comprise a minimum amount of territory?
