SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then... Oh, thank you. Oh, I thought somebody's going to give me a more precise answer. Thank you. If you adopt this amendment I'd be willing to amend it to extend its scope to be sure that we include those areas where we slaughter fowls, whether chickens, turkeys or whatever. Then there's something for everybody and in this instance a person's conscience might not whip them for shooting at these confined animals because ultimately the animals will be used for food. With these confined areas for the controlled shooting, as it's called, we don't what becomes of those animals after they have been shot so I'm offering this modest proposal for your consideration.
