SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, what seems preposterous in my amendment in the minds of the other Senators will help them understand my view of what they're proposing in this bill where they call it controlled shooting. I'd like to ask Senator Schrock a question.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, have you ever been to one of these controlled shooting areas which is controlled by a corporation to which they invite their clients?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I have not but the people who have Arapahoe have invited me to come down and observe their operation this fall when...when controlled shooting starts and I'm looking forward to it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then you don't really know whether these big shots, who go there and shoot up trees and leaves and whatever else might be available, what they would do if they happened to hit one of these creatures.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, I do know the group that has the controlled hunting area at Arapahoe do use...they use dogs and the dogs will point the game out and then after the game is shot the dogs will retrieve them or bring them back to them and that's really quite beneficial 'cause they... they lose a lot less game that way and they're more apt to be able to retrieve something that's wounded and not killed and therefore not let the creatures suffer.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you... Okay, I'll ask...maybe Senator Avery has been to one to observe. Senator Avery, have you ever been to one of these areas to which corporations invite clients and customers and potential clients and customers to observe this activity in progress?

SENATOR AVERY: I have been to an area to inspect it, look at it. I haven't been there when they have had clients. In asking them what procedures they go through, safety is the utmost. They make sure that they're advised and instructed on safety, make sure they're advised and instructed on Nebraska's laws and regulations, you know, but I haven't been there while clients
