

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But since I've been asking you all those questions I wanted to put that one to you also since there is no minimum age for the child. Senator Avery, do you know whether when they... When you're in the army they have what they call as skirmishers. That means that everybody lines up in a row and you move kind of as a line with each other so no individual is in front of the other ones.

SENATOR AVERY: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So is that kind of the way they do when they turn these hunters loose to shoot? They kind of walk side-by-side so that none will be in front of the others and perhaps be treated as quarry, because I understand pheasants are pretty fast and a person could get frustrated...

SENATOR AVERY: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ..being unable to hit a pheasant, hit a more slow-moving target.

SENATOR AVERY: (Laugh) You're right, and my understanding is, and that's how the areas that I've been on, they do not allow...usually they restrict it to the number of people on the area...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And they keep...

SENATOR AVERY: ..on a certain, in a certain area.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: They keep...they supervise these people to make sure that they're not just going helter-skelter at random throughout this area.

SENATOR AVERY: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Has anybody ever been injured in one of these shoots that you know of?

SENATOR AVERY: I don't know. I don't...not that I know of.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. I'm going to vote against this bill, but as I told Senator Hudkins, at least on General File, it's not one of those bills that I'm going to do everything I can...
