SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body, I rise in support of the motion to overrule the Chair and, Senator Chambers, I know where you're coming from and I sympathize with it and I agree with you and I think, you know, so many things were wrong about that situation, but there were a lot of people whose lives were affected by that war, black people and white people alike. And there were many people who served in that war who came back, but you know, lost something precious out of their lives from the time they spent serving in that war. And I think it is only in recognition of all of those people, both black and white, those who lived and those who died that Senator Robinson... sorry.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Fisher.

SENATOR FISHER: Madam President, members, I just rise in support of Senator Robinson's motion. I was quite surprised this morning when I looked at the agenda and there was not a resolution on there. I thought it was quite improper and I must say I did drop the ball. I got tied up on some other phone calls or I would have pursued a little bit further, but I think we ought to do it. I think this is an appropriate case to override the Speaker. Thank you. Or President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Fisher. Seeing no further lights, Senator Robinson, to close on the motion to overrule the Chair. Closing is waived. The question before the body is the motion to overrule the Chair on the decision to rule Senator Robinson's point of personal privilege out of order. There has been a request for a roll call vote. There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
