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to whether the dollars are going to be over here or over here.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right, it's just another account, so to speak, to account for this particular fund.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Okay, fine. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Madam President. I...I'm sorry, Senator Wehrbein, a couple more questions,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BROMM: ...if you would, please. Do you know where...where DEQ is taking the ten people from that they're going to shift into the clean air area? Did they...did they make that...did they represent something to the committee that you can share with us or that you recall?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We think some of the water quality, we don't know specifically, but some of the water quality people. We've been assured it will be a zero staff, zero net increase in staff totally. They'll be transferred from other divisions.

SENATOR BROMM: So...and will these ten people all be, their...their entire salaries will be covered by this, this generation fee, this cash fund?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR BROMM: So is there an appropriate decrease in DEQ's budget since...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We decreased General Funds by 350,000.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. The ten people that are being moved to this clean air section, do you know who's been paying them in the past?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, if they came out of water quality that would be some of them. I just don't know where the others were exactly. And they wouldn't necessarily all be General, but we did reduce General Funding in...to...in the same area by that much money.
