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LB 311

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...is what you're talking about.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And because they're not fully funded...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...or fully vested till...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...they've been here five years, some of them may, say, leave in three years,...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...that money is there,...

SENATOR ROBINSON: And that's the pot that...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...that share.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...it's taken out of.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah, okay. I just wanted to get clarified on it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Is there any further discussion on the advancement? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, after a little consultation, which didn't cost me anything, I want to ask Senator Wehrbein a question.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Wehrbein, if this bill advances and ultimately is passed, we would not have a bill asking for the deficit appropriation as we did in January, which informed the Legislature of what had occurred and money that had to be returned to the federal government.
