

line 1, on page 4, line 21, after "department" insert "in accordance with the purposes stated in subsection (2) of this section. That would be part one of the first division. The second division would be on, again, the same page, starting with line 19, and it would then flow from line 19 to the end of the amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yeah.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay, so it would be to the rest of the page. That would be the second part that Senator Wickersham would like to pick up. And, again, to repeat, that would be line 19, which would be subsection (e) to the rest...through the rest of the amendment. And then the third and final part would be that portion after the word "section" in line 3 through line 18, and that would include the areas that we are talking about that people would have more of a concern. Now Senator...Senator Janssen's amendment he was talking about would not be...would not be a part of any of this division if he was looking at that, that would still be on the E & R amendment, so that would even be after, Senator Janssen, these three divisions, in case you were looking to see where yours might fit in on that. It would not in this...it would not be ready for discussion at this point. So that would be the nature of the division, if it would be approved by the Chair.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. I rule that the amendment is divided into three sections as outlined. Section 1 will be lines 1 through 3, ending on line 3 with the word "section". Second section will be lines 19 through 23 on page 1, and lines 1 through 4 on page 2, and the remainder of the amendment will be the third section taken up.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: That is correct, and Senator Wickersham, again, I believe wants to pick those up in the order that we just talked about, the first, the second at the bottom, and then the third in the middle. Would that be correct, Bob?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That is correct.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wickersham, we will begin with the first section of the amendment which is on page 4, line 21, after "department" insert "in accordance with the purposes stated in subsection (2) of this section." Senator Wickersham. (EA201 appears on page 2(32 of the Legislative Journal.)
