

be, and those are going to be broader, not so much even on... on the public or the governmental subdivisions, but it will be on individuals, those people that are involved in court actions, and of course the lawyers aren't going to eat those fees. They just will pass them on. And I think that fact, it's going to impact drastically a lot of other people. I would...I'm...I think I'm going to, on the basis of the amendment, I think what Landis said is right, I think they need a potential cost increase, but I think we need to look at this in depth and I hope it can...the process will continue that way, but these type of increases are going to have a far-reaching impact and I'm going to have to throw up a red light as well initially here and I hope that everyone seriously considers all the points and the impact of this. This is a mandate that we should seriously consider. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEN: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, during some of the years that I was down here bills of this kind would come through the Judiciary Committee. What Senator Landis said is absolutely true. Any time an effort is made to cut out something that's called the public notice here they come, and I'm not going to repeat everything Senator Landis said because it cannot be improved upon but I want to confirm and verify that what he says has happened repeatedly during my time here as a member of the Legislature. He has...he has turned on a light in my mind and what I'm going to do is talk to Bill Drafting and get them to run a computer search and find for me every place in the statute where a public notice is required and I'm going to bring in a bill to do away with those which, in my judgment, make no sense and I'd be willing to talk to anybody or work with anybody who is interested, but because it might be an arduous undertaking I'm not going to try to rope anybody in at this point, but it is something that I intend to undertake and it can get us into a discussion of broader issues than just the amount that will be chargeable for the running of these notices. We will make sure that there is a rational relationship between the notice that we require to be published and the result that we hope to achieve by it. It does no value to say we're going to put these things in the paper just so we can say that things had been put in the newspaper. We have to, not only in this area but others where we legislate, start trying to make sure that there is a nexus, that's what the law calls it, or a direct connection between what it is we do and what it is we hope to
