The way it is now is there is a transfer of those who volunteer. And the interesting question would be, can you be forced to volunteer? I don't know how that works. I have some other amendments filed on this bill on the amendment 1575 that will get to some of those other questions and concerns on the way the amendment is written. But, members of the body, I hope that we get away from the idea that we all support foster care, we like these kids, we want to do everything we can for the kids, we want to do the reviews, and this is the way to do it. I would foster care. I want to do all the reviews. I want to do it better than we have...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: ...before. I want to make sure that we have people working together on it, but this is not the way to do it. And so I hope this just isn't I like foster care, this is, like, you know, this is something I should vote for because I agree we need to do the reviews. Take some time, look at the whole issue because it is much more complex than what Senator Avery is indicating.
