

being considered in a fiscal note to know what those will cost. I think the other thing that I would like to remind the members is that when the Foster Care Review Board, if the Foster Care Review Board would take over all of the reviews, we're assuming that a lot of the problems that DSS has dealt with are going to go away. They're not. A lot of the problems that we find with DSS and their wards is that it's the rules, the regulations, the philosophy that comes from the federal government that says reunification with the family. Foster Care Review Board is going to have to work in that same system. Some of the objections that we have as individuals, what we consider problems with DSS, is some things that they don't have any control over. Foster Care Review Board will not create a whole new system to which they are going to be working in. They will fall under the same rules, the same regulations, the same compliance acts that DSS does, so they're not going to be able to go in there and just completely do things as they want. They're going to have to work within the present structure that's there. The other thing, in looking, I guess I would like to mention with code agency with Foster Care Review Board, I don't wish to single out any agency, but we have had, from time to time,...

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR HILLMAN: ...those agencies that are not code agencies that work under commissions that come up periodically, be it Game and Parks, NEOC, that the attempt is made to make those code agencies over and over and over again. We're looking at creating then the same situation with the Foster Care Review Board that has told us with past experience that perhaps having another agency that is not a code agency that is directed by a commission may not be totally what we're wanting either.
