

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 389.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 389. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Opposed vote aye. Excuse me, let's go back through that again. Supportive vote aye. Opposed vote nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Senator Maurstad, I apologize. That was a tough one, I understand.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: It's a struggle at times.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, this is a committee amendment that we filed on LB 389 from the Appropriations Committee. It corrects an oversight that we did not provide full PSL for the Workmen's Comp Court at four and three and a half percent. It's simply an oversight in the mainline, in the main bill that we intended to fully fund the PSL so workmen's comp would have adequate PSL. It happens to be \$88,085 in '95-96; \$98,797 in fiscal year '96-97. No additional funding is required. I want to emphasize that. It's no additional funding. It's simply to increase their PSL so they have adequate salary leeway in their bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the amendment. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, any closing, Senator Wehrbein? Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of the Amendment 2077 offered by Senator Wehrbein. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted. Anything further?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
