

like to do it all, but you can't do it all. And I don't sense a real sense of realism here this afternoon. We acknowledge we've got someplace between 17 and 23 million dollars of A bills we can deal with. The crime bill is 8 million, the child care credit is 10 million, the SEED bill is 16 million, that's 24 million without even mentioning ethanol, which I think for most of us comes first. And this is not a rural development...urban development thing, I think, quite clearly, ethanol is the thing that's on most of our minds, and that's traditionally thought of as a rural development proposition. But you can't have these three bills, totaling \$24 million, plus ethanol which is \$16 million, within \$24 million, we're \$16 million over, Senator Bernard-Stevens says \$12 million, we've got to get real here. I mean, this isn't the only bill we've got to get rid of unless you all are going to send over to the Governor a budget that is really somewhat irresponsible. We've got to take some action. And it seems to me that this bill is logical, we're not killing it, we're asking for some further development of it. And God knows, as the debate has gone, I think you're all cognizant of some further refinement that's needed in the bill. We've done a lot for economic development, it's logical to hold the line here a little bit for one year, it's a logical place. And I would just hope that a sense of realism is going to come over this body and we're going to make a decision here today that gets us on our way towards a responsible budget. Senator Hall, I'd like to have a call of the house and a roll call vote.
