

bill insisted needed to be there so that it is clear what the purpose of this bill is, to make sure that there are some limitations on how and where and when this money can be used. Instead of it just being open-ended to anybody who says I want to get a loan because I don't want to go to a commercial lender, therefore, I want to tap into this fund, that would not happen. One of the requirements is that we must have a business which some other state is either trying to lure from Nebraska or prevent from coming to Nebraska, or to avoid that business expanding in Nebraska, but rather moving part of its operation someplace else. So since the purpose of the bill, the thing that got it to this point, the thing that helped persuade the Legislature to support it was that its aim is to keep Nebraska competitive in these competitive situations which have states giving away so much and so much to businesses, I am saying since that was the reason given for this bill, we ought to keep that language in the bill. Those who brought us the bill did not feel it hurt their purposes. It will not hurt those purposes now, so I am asking that you accept this part of the amendment. And the fact that there was no opposition may mean that people understand why it is being offered and agree to it. I will have to ask for a call of the house, though, Mr. President.
