SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Maurstad. Excuse me, discussion on the bill? If not, Senator Maurstad, you're recognized at this point. Senator Kristensen, would you take over for the E & R Chair? Oh, there's Senator Maurstad. Thank you.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 646 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Appears to the Chair that the ayes have it. Bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record. Excuse me, 646A. Mr. Clerk, are there any amendments?

CLERK: No, sir, I have no amendments to LB 646A.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Maurstad. Senator, state your point.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I just want to make sure you're dealing with 646A?

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: That is correct.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I don't see that on the agenda.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator, what we've done is on 646, on the A bills we have, if they're on the same...if they're on the same level, we have tried to keep them together when at all possible. That's the precedent we set a couple of days ago.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I understand the precedent, however, because of the substantive change there's going to need to be an amendment placed on LB 646A because of the Kristensen-Hall-Lindsay amendment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator, I could suggest a motion you could do to have it laid over if you wish or if you want to just ask unanimous consent to pass over the bill, we could do so.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would ask for unanimous consent to pass over the bill.
