

Employees Collective Bargaining Act which uses special masters generally charge the parties for the cost of the special master. So the fiscal note says that political subdivisions that go through the special master process would possibly incur some additional cost since they have gone through two steps instead of one. I think before the bill comes to final consideration here that it will be well for us to make a record to clarify that at least if not an amendment, at least that's my feeling. And so with that, I'll just urge the adoption of this amendment. Thank you.
