

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Senator Cudaback, that's true, this is for next year's budget starting July 1st.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Right.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And so this money, if this were to pass, there would be \$2.8 million less in the budget for that reason this year and the next year. So the amount would be reduced. There's no way that there could be any funny business, so to speak.

SENATOR CUDABACK: That would be from the current dollars there, right?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's right.

SENATOR CUDABACK: But then if we took this out then the next year and next year and next year they would not have the opportunity to transfer it into this so-called fund, right?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, they wouldn't get it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: They wouldn't get it.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The money...if the budget this year is \$10 and next it's \$10 and we take back \$2, they are only going to get \$8 as of July 1st to run the next year's budget, I mean.

SENATOR CUDABACK: But if they do have a vacancy and they are...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...they save \$50 the next year, doesn't that...where is that \$50 going to go to?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, we've taken back the money so if they have a vacancy, if...they simply are not going to be able to fund all of their faculty in this case if there would be no vacancy. See, the vacancies, somebody resigns, somebody goes on a leave of absence, or whatever,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yeah, uh-huh.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...probably not leave of absence but they
