

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please return to the Chamber. Members in the Chamber, please record your presence. The house is under call. The question is, shall debate cease? The introducer of the motion has authorized call-in votes. The house is under call. I might announce it would be my intention to keep the house under call until the Hall amendment...the deci...this body makes its decision on the Hall amendment. I don't even recall asking, Senator Chambers.

CLERK: Senator Cudaback voting yes. Senator Jensen voting yes. Senator Wesely voting yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, and 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Debate is ceased. The house is still under call. Members are to be in their seats. We still have a few absent members. Senator Hall, you are recognized to close.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members, and I appreciate the debate on both sides of the issue, but I do rise in support of the amendment and offer it to you because what it does is it appropriates \$125,000 each year of the biennium for a total of 250,000 to be put into five new family planning clinics that are out there. The clinics would go into the more rural parts of the state, actually where the need exists. There was a study that was done by the Health Department and they determined that in order to meet the need that is out there, we needed to appropriate \$425,000. This won't meet the need, but it is a start. We do appropriate \$185,000 in the budget, but that. Senator Wehrbein, goes for Pap smears and chlamydia testing and treatment. It is not a broad-based family planning application like these monies would be used for. The types of agencies that provide this service to low income, and poor women, and teens, the University of Nebraska Med Center, there is a community hospital that meets this criteria. There is a community action agency and a community health center that provides this. There are two Planned Parenthoods, and the remaining six are independent agencies, not for profit, that provide these types of services to low income women. By providing this type of money, these types of money, we're...have the potential to save tremendous dollars in terms of the kinds of welfare reform issues that we talk about.
