SENATOR AVERY: Record vote.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Please record. There's been a request for a record vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2181-82 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 16 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Avery amendment fails. Mr. Clerk, anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, Madam President, I do.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: I raise the call.
