SENATOR DAY: I would assume that it is.

SENATOR BEUTLER: It would be your intent that they would be. Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah, I hope Senator Beutler's answers were...questions were answered. I think there...I'll try and find it but there is a specific reference on that, that they are responsible to the consumer. So I think you're...I'll try and find that for you. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there anything further on the motion to return to Select File? Senator Day waives closing. The question before you is the motion to return LB 563 to Select File. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion passes. The Chair recognizes Senator Day.

SENATOR DAY: I would just urge the body to adopt this amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion on the Day amendment? Seeing none, Senator Day, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Day amendment to LB 563. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Select File amendment, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Day.
