LB 140, 438, 563, 856

SENATOR DAY: I would move this bill to be readvanced to E & R for Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2233-34 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 9 nays, Madam President, on the passage of LB 856.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 856 passes. LB 140.

CLERK: (Read LB 140 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 140 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2234-35 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 9 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 140 passes. LB 438.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 438 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 438 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2235 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting.
