SENATOR KRISTENSEN: The minimums range from 51 for the 22, to 55, roughly, for the 23.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Right, and on the grade 23 was 70...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: At the max it would ever be is 74 and the other one the max is roughly 69.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. I just wanted to refresh my memory on that because I remember we discussed that and that was, as I recall, pretty much in the range that we'd...that I had talked about with my amendment that I withdrew simply because you were following pretty much that same and it would not require us every year go in and try to make adjustments. I think that appeared to be the advantage that we would, in fact...they would go with the grade raise based on the state's contract, right?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: They would be similar to other people that we've got working like in the Department of Revenue...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Right.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...and so on. In fact, that's probably commensurate with people that I went through and looked at what some of those other would be. It's the Deputy Tax Commissioner, the Deputy Lottery Director, the heads of those areas.

SENATOR VRTISKA: So I guess the only thing I had to say was I supported the amendment because it pretty much fell in line with what we had talked about so I just indicate that I supported the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Kristensen. Ie waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LB 490A. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Kristensen amendment. Have you all voted? Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President. I would ask for a call of the house, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: There is a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.
