LB 490A, 519

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We're voting on the Kristensen amendment to LB 490A and Senator Kristensen has indicated he will accept call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Wickersham voting yes. Senator Pedersen voting...you had voted yes, Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR CROSBY: Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. I will raise the call. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 490A to E & R for grossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 490A to E & R for grossment. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. The next item is General File, LB 519. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 519, a bill introduced by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17, referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. Senator, I don't know if you'd like to offer your bill or offer your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The bill first.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Chambers, to open on LB 519.
