ASSISTANT CLERK: There is no line number indicated on the amendment Senator. It just says, page 4 after, "she".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'll find it, just a minute. Oh, it should be line 5, page 4, I mean... yes, page 4, line 5, and Senator Wehrbein, after "she", I am putting "knowingly and" and then it says, "knowingly and intentionally teases", that means that you know this is the animal and you intend to do it and when we create crimes, these two words are always there, you "knowingly and" intentionally do the act. You may intend to do what you are doing but you may not know that it is this particular... you know, a police animal.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I understand that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so that is what that amendment would do. Just add the words, "knowingly and".

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, if that is your formal proposal of your amendment, I formally accept your amendment.
