

support it, those who may have some problems with it do come to the table and I think the best means of having that happen would be see that this does get on Select File. I don't think that we'd be hurrying the debate on it. I don't think that we would be hurting the bill in the long run and I would encourage you to vote against the bracket motion and then vote to move this to Select File. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Bernard-Stevens, your light is next, followed by Senators Elmer and Jones.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body, and, Senator Schimek, it is for many of the reasons you just mentioned that I'll be supporting the bracket motion and where this Chamber is so much fun because we all look at the same set of facts and we come to different conclusions and the majority is going to rule. The only thing I got from Senator Preister and I understand what he is doing is that a compromise was reached between what I could tell, the person who likes the bill, who prioritized it and the person who introduced the bill and they came to a compromise and they said well let's move it to Select File and then we'll do the interim study. Well, that's fine, but what I'm going to do, at least personally is I listened to what Senator Preister was saying and what Senator Preister said is what they want to do and they've already got it introduced is they'll have this interim study and to take Senator Preister's words, lots of things that are related are going to be talked about so we have no idea what in fact is going to be recommended and what all things are going to be...things that will come out of that interim study. We all know how it will work when we get here next year. We're going to be a lot calmer, it's going to be a lot easier, we've got the whole session in front of us and we've got a big amendment in front of us, we're not quite sure what it does, we're going to be...it sounds good, yeah, I'll vote for the committee amendments, it sounds good, we move on and then all of sudden people out in the outside of the Legislature start reading and all of a sudden they look at it and they'll say did you know that this little section was in there? And we'll say, well I didn't really notice that. Well we'll go back and fix it except now we're on Final Reading and you can't do that because you moved it to Select today, then we move it real quick next week or next year when we get there and then we find out what some of the things that need to be done and then we have to try to bring it back from Final Reading and then you're going to have the
