It just makes sense that if we're going to have an interim study anyway and we're going to look at all the criteria anyway, let's just keep it where it's at, do what Senator Hall wants to do and it maintains its priority status. When we come back next year it will be one of the first bills we talk about because we will go to senator priority bill of this year. We'll begin those next year, we'll have the interim study, we'll have the recommendations, it moves quickly at the beginning of next year's Select File and we're on our way and the bill will pass. It will have no difficulties but we'll at least be able to look at it two rounds of debate and on the outside chance that it may have difficulties because of what is put into the bill, then we probably need two rounds of debate. And so it just makes sense to do what Senator Hall does, particularly when the movers of the bill don't want to bring the bill up till next year anyway.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Elmer.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Madam President. Senator Hall, you finally made a good motion. This bill, we may not even need it when they discover all of the things that the federal government is doing. They may need, just find out we need it badly and may decide we need a different bill to do the same thing and introduce it and have a new hearing next year. But what Senator Beutler is talking about has merit. What Senator Bernard-Stevens is talking about has merit, but I certainly believe that given the circumstances that we would be wise to support Senator Hall's bracket motion. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Elmer. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Madam President and members of the body, I stand in support of the bracket motion because I think that the idea they are going to have an interim study and I really think they do need it with the problems with the bill and I do think they need two stages of debate when they come back next year. If we get back here and all of a sudden it's up to Final Reading you got to pull it back just specific amendments and it could get strung out a long time so I'm sure glad to see this bracket motion up and I hope you support it. Thank you.
