

Christmas tree of bills that has nothing to do with the original bill, fine, vote against the override. But if you want to follow the present rules then you will vote to overrule the Chair. Thank you very much.

**SPEAKER WITHEM:** Senator Beutler, for what purpose do you rise?

**SENATOR BEUTLER:** Senator Withem, since this is an unusual kind of vote, would you remind us what votes are necessary on this kind of vote.

**SPEAKER WITHEM:** Yes, I certainly will, Senator Beutler. At this point the motion to overrule the Chair rule indicates that we need a majority of those present. At this time a majority of those present, present being defined as individuals who are authorized to vote who are not excused. The vote needed to overrule would be 19. It's possible that that will change as the vote proceeds. At this time the question before the body is, shall the Chair be overruled? If you wish to overrule the Chair then you will vote yes. If you wish to sustain the Chair you will vote no. Senator Chambers has requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

**CLERK:** (Roll call vote taken. See page 2325 of the Legislative Journal.) 7 ayes, 24 nays on the motion to overrule the Chair.

**SPEAKER WITHEM:** Chair is not overridden. The...we will now move to consideration of LB 392. Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, LB 392, the first amendment this morning by Senator Witek. Senator, AM2090 in front of me. (The Witek amendment appears on page 2151 of the Legislative Journal.)

**SPEAKER WITHEM:** Senator Witek, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

**SENATOR WITEK:** Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, what my amendment would do would be to freeze the General Fund appropriation for NETV, the Historical Society and the Arts Council at their '94-95 level for the next two years. I guess I have come to the conclusion that it's been very difficult for some members of this body, a majority of members of this body to cut anything from the budget. So what I'm now suggesting that we do is take areas of the budget where we freeze the appropriations at the '94-95 level for two years. In this case,
