

SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, item 8 of AM2061 would involve on page 8, lines 9 through 12.

SPEAKER WITHEM: We have...Senator Lindsay has already opened on the amendment, so we are now in a position then of discussing the item 8 on your list, and as I am presiding here, I will be referring to this sheet that has been distributed. Senator Lindsay, you are recognized to speak on the amendment.
