

effectively. It's worked well. I question the need for this at all but certainly on the issue of whether you're going to include motor vehicle homicide, along with murder and other serious intentional crimes, is not a logical comparison and I will support Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Matzke. There are no further lights. Senator Chambers, you may close on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, I cannot improve on what Senator Matzke said, but I wanted to say this for the record. As I stated in the beginning, bill drafting is working on putting the appropriate language and references to this amendment so what we're voting on is what we have discussed and bill drafting is going to make sure that the language in the amendment uses that type of language necessary. And because we are so few in numbers, Madam President, I'm going to ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CROSBY: There's a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.
