SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: ...in the right direction.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. We have several lights on. Senator Schimek, Chambers, Beutler, Bernard-Stevens, Hillman, Pedersen and Robak. Senator Schimek, on the Withem amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Madam President, and members of the body, I don't know for sure I'm going to vote on this amendment or on this motion but I guess...and I guess my knee-jerk reaction is to vote for the Withem and Bernard-Stevens amendment because everything I read about boot camps in the past has been...has been negative, frankly. They haven't done the job that they were...that they purported to do in the beginning and almost all the states experience. However, I haven't made this a big matter for investigation so I guess I'm trying to learn here all I can in the short time that we have to help me make a decision. One of the things that I've...from what I have read that I know that we need to do if we're going to have effective boot camps is to have programs, and I'm looking at the language of the bill and, Senator Lindsay, I don't know if you're on the floor still but I'm going to want to ask you a question or two. I'm looking at the language of the bill and it says that to accomplish these goals the boot camps shall provide structured programming, including any of the following, work programs, vocational training, behavior management and modification, money management, substance abuse awareness, counseling or treatment or other education and programming needs. Now it doesn't say you have to provide all of those. It just says any, and I have a problem with that kind of nebulous language because I don't know what these boot camps will really do. But my question is, Senator Lindsay, as I look at the fiscal note and the latest I'm looking at, I guess, is April 10th, I don't know if that's the
