

latest one or not, but it mentions, under the programming costs for boot camps, under this bill, as you get into the actual operation it mentions only education and substance abuse. It doesn't mention any other programs. How did...you know, how did we come up with those? Does this preclude things like work experience, work programs, some of those kinds of things? Is that...can you tell me more about the programming aspect of this?

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I can. The Department of Corrections has a...I think I will get this copied and sent around. The Department of Corrections has their...what they're looking at for programming and I will read you directly from what they have. What they're talking about is that the rehabilitative and treatment programs shall be provided by the department to include any of the following, work programs, vocational programs, behavior management and modification, money management, substance abuse awareness,...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That's just...

SENATOR LINDSAY: ...substance abuse counseling.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That's what's in the bill.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay, and they are...they have...they have figured that into their...into their planning. Now whether they've got the...how they calculate that out of the fiscal note is if they've broken that down and are including, for example, the counseling, treatment and awareness of substance abuse all within the substance abuse section of that fiscal note, and whether education includes not only a classroom type of education and vocational type of education, I'm assuming that is all...those are collapsed into those categories.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Well,...

SENATOR LINDSAY: But they have consistently indicated that that is part of what...the language that was included in the bill came from the language that they...from their plan...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.
