CLERK: Senator Will voting yes.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The house is under call. Looking for Senators Lynch, Pirsch, Cudaback, Senator Schmitt, Senator Elmer and Senator Wesely.

CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The house is under call. Call-in votes are being accepted.

CLERK: Senator Hillman voting yes. Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator Janssen voting yes. Senator Schmitt voting yes.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.
