And maybe that's some of the programs that will open up with the last line of your amendment saying that any program that they deem necessary maybe will even initiate some of those hard work programs. But I guess my concern and the reason I...

SENATOR HALL: One minute.

SENATOR WITEK: ...won't be voting for the amendment is the same reason I didn't vote for the boot camps, it's not that I didn't want the boot camp provision, it's that we can't afford everything that everybody wants, even in the area of corrections we have to draw the line on some of these expenditures, and that's what I was doing, I was drawing the line on some of those expenditures. And this is what I'll be doing again. It's enough for me to have the good time out there, and it's enough for me to deal with the programs that we already have started in the prison system. I don't think we need to start anymore and that's why I won't be supporting this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Witek. Senator Will, your light is next.

SENATOR WILL: Yield to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Chambers, you're recognized.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Will. Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, did you hear Senator Witek? Now you know why I love her so. When I hear her speak like that my heart leaps up, because it shows us a side of life that many of us don't look at as we should. But then it makes me think of other things. I read someplace a long time ago where there were these religious big shots and they were all sitting around congratulating themselves. And then this guy walked in with a robe and the beard, and you know who I'm talking about, and he said, when I was hungry you didn't feed me, when I was thirsty you didn't give me a drink of water.
