

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a priority motion. Senator Lindsay would move to invoke cloture pursuant to Rule 7, Section 10.

SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Lindsay has made the motion to invoke cloture. The question before the body then is, shall cloture be invoked? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2354-55 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to invoke cloture, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Cloture has been adopted. Debate will now cease on LB 371. Our rules call for us to now vote on the pending matter. The rules indicate that if the pending matter is in...excuse me, if the original amendment has been divided and the original amendment we're dealing with is AM2061, if it has been divided then the vote shall be on the undivided amendment being considered. There are two provisions then of the amendment that have not fully been considered. They are the probation officers' salary, equalization and the civil liability for terrorist threats. The question before the body is, shall the remainder of AM2061 be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the balance of the Judiciary Committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The committee amendments are adopted. The pending matter is now disposed of. The vote now will be on the advancement of the bill. The question before the body is, shall LB 371 be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2356 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 2 nays on the advancement of LB 371, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 371 advances. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record?
