LB 189A, 394

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: This simply removes the judicial branch salaries from LB 394. It leaves the other constitutional officers in with the intent that their...and theirs, we'll pay the judicial branch now with an amendment on LB 189A to the appropriations process, and so in order to clean 394 up so that it was properly drafted for those officers that the body apparently would agree with, and I would urge the adoption of this amendment, which will then leave the committee amendments strictly to pay the rest of the constitutional officers.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I do correct on that, this still pays the judges; it does not give their increase. That will be found in LB 189A.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You have heard the opening on Senator Wehrbein's amendment to the committee amendments. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Wehrbein, would you care to close?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I hope that's clear. This does do the paying, but the increases will be found in LB 189A, which I assume will be following. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. You've heard the close. The question is the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment to the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR HALL: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted. Any further to the committee amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers, I had a motion for reconsideration by you.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw that.

SENATOR HALL: If there is no objection, so ordered.
