

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: A call of the house and we will have a roll call vote taken in regular order.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. The question is, shall the house go under call. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR HALL: The house is under call. All members please record their presence. Those off the floor, please return to the floor and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor, the house is under call. Senator Avery, if you would check in. Thank you. Senator Beutler, thank you very much. Senator Brown, Senator Chambers, Senator Preister, Senator Coordsen, Senator Cudaback, Senator Robinson, the house is under call. Senator Schrock, Senator Hillman, Senator Vrtiska, the house is under call. Please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Schrock, would you record your presence. Thank you. Senators Coordsen, Cudaback, Vrtiska. Senator Lynch, Senator Robinson, and Senator Janssen. It sounds like the LB 309 Committee. If we could ask you folks to please return to the Chamber, the house is under call. All members who are not excused are present. Senator Bernard-Stevens, you requested a roll call vote in regular order. We are voting on the adoption of the Bernard-Stevens amendment to LB 742A. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2368-69 of the Legislative Journal.) 11 ayes, 14 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: The amendment fails. Anything further on the bill.

CLERK: Senator Bernard-Stevens, would move to reconsider the vote just taken, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Bernard-Stevens, you are recognized to open on your motion.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I do not plan on bringing this reconsideration to a vote and will make a few comments.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Bernard-Stevens, I would raise the call.
