

authority is given to the Executive Board when we're not in session. The other...I think that covers the gift area. In the scope area it is made clear that the colleges and the university are not subject to the comprehensive planning requirements. They are exempted again because of the coverage in the Postsecondary Coordinating Commission. There is an exception created also for Game and Parks. That is a twofold exception, one due to federal requirements. The Game and Parks Commission as a recipient of certain federal funds could not lose control. That is a technical term of properties for which they have received federal funds. Those are going to be explicitly excluded wherever those are. The other exclusion are for the parks' properties and it was never intended as I understand it that DAS would be seeking to provide maintenance for example, police security, janitorial services, et cetera, on the various park facilities that we have across the State of Nebraska and you'll see those itemized. We have state historical parks, we have recreational areas, et cetera, so you see an itemization of those kinds of properties. The bill wasn't intended to apply to those. There may be some, there might be Game and Parks properties that it does apply to, for example, such as headquarter's buildings, et cetera, and those properties are not excluded. All we're excluding are the buildings in which we receive federal funds and we would violate the requirements of the federal funding acts by transferring control of those buildings to DAS and also excluding the park properties where it would be inappropriate for DAS to provide various services. I think that...there are other quite technical aspects of the amendment, but I think that gives you the broad scope of what it does. If you have specific questions, I'll be happy to try to respond.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Senator Cudaback, on the Wickersham amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. President, members, I took this, LB 530 as a priority because I wanted to help, not hinder different situations. We thought we had things worked out prior to this amendment by Senator Wickersham but there was still some areas that might cause, be of concern to like Game and Parks and so on. So anything we can do to relieve that situation where it might stop the incoming dollars from helping us out in the endeavor that we want to pursue, I'm certainly for and this amendment by Senator Wickersham I think probably does this so it's a good amendment.
