ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, we have two reports from the Natural Resources Committee. The first is found on page 2330 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, is this the Environmental Trust?

ASSISTANT CLERK: This is relating to the Environmental Trust Board, three members.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. The Natural Resources Committee, members of the Legislature, desires to report favorably upon the appointment of those nominees to the Environmental Trust Board that are shown on the appropriate Journal page and would advise or would ask that the Legislature confirm the appointments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Beutler, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Natural Resources Committee confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the confirmation report.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, the second confirmation report is found in the Journal on page 2331 and it also is from the Natural Resources Committee.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler.
