CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2400-01 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to suspend the rules.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The rules are suspended. Debate ceases. We now move to the advancement of LB 392. There is a request for a machine vote. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 392. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2402 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 15 nays on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 392 advances. We now turn to Item 10 on the agenda, and Final Reading. I raise the call. Senator Withem, did you wish to proceed with the budget bills or to go to Item 10 on the agenda?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Just one second, let me check, confer with you a second.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Before we move to Item 10 on the agenda, we will finish Item 8 on the agenda, Select File, LB 394.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator, to 394.
